Re: Year 2 SATS

As you know, by the end of this year we need to make judgements about the standard your child has reached in Reading, Writing and Maths by the end of Key Stage 1. This judgement is decided by teachers based on work throughout the year.

We also use national curriculum tests (SATs) in Reading, Maths (Reasoning and Arithmetic) to help inform our judgements. The results of these tests are **NOT** published like the Year 6 SATs results. They are mainly used as a tool that helps teachers to measure your child's performance and identify some of their needs as they move into Key Stage 2 next year.

As a way of supporting your child in reaching their end of year expected level, we would like to invite you to a SATs Parents' meeting on **Tuesday 5 March 2019** in the **KS2 Hall at 2.30 pm**.

The meeting will provide information about how the tests are structured, show you some examples of questions and how you can support your child. The meeting should last no longer than **25 minutes**.

We would greatly **appreciate your support** by attending this meeting as we will also be able to answer any questions you may have regarding SATs.
