

The PTA will be selling snacks after school in the main school playground on Mon 29th Jan. Sweet & Savoury all 50p each (cash only please)



### **Year 6 SATS**


SATs (Standard Assessment Tests) are designed to evaluate your child's progress throughout years 3-6 and to compare how your child achieves against other children of their age. For example, Ofsted look at SATs results. SATs exams are set and marked outside the school.
