

In school, we have begun learning about fairy tales, and the language we would use when writing a story.

Your task today is to write the **end** of your fairy tale.

- Who saves the main character?
- How are they saved?

Encourage your child to use some of these phrases in their ending '*one day, the end, soon, happily ever after*'.

When your child is writing their story, let them use their phonic knowledge to sound out their words. Don't worry about correct spelling e.g. your child may write 'sayvd (saved) or 'prins' (prince).

Their story might go something like this: 'Soon the prince found Belle and saved her from the poisonous grape. They lived happily ever after. The end.'
