





What Parents & Educators Need to Know about **ROBLOX**

Roblox is one of the most popular video games among children. In 2020, the game's developers claimed that more than half of the UK's children had played it. As a 'sandbox' title, the game lets players create their own gaming experiences with Roblox Studio to build custom levels, which can then be shared online.

WHAT ARE THE RISKS?

- ONLINE PLAY RISKS**: Because Roblox connects random players across the world, it can be a social playground where an unmoderated chat system could be used to harass or bully other players. For example, some chat systems allow users to send online dates and invite others to play, which could expose your child to inappropriate messages in the public chat box.
- MATURE CONTENT**: Content is difficult to moderate throughout Roblox, due to the number of games available. This is particularly notable on smaller games and experiences, but in general, some of the games and experiences offered on the platform contain age-inappropriate content that could easily be seen by younger players.
- IN-GAME SPENDING**: The majority of games within Roblox have an in-game purchase system, usually through season passes or microtransactions. Purchases can range in value from a few pence up to much larger sums of money. While some games offer a lot of content for purchase, others can offer very little for real world money, causing younger players to end up in debt.
- ANONYMOUS PLAYERS**: The anonymity of users can leave players vulnerable to bullying, harassment, and predatory behaviour. Without the digital parents who can monitor their children's online requests, and it is very difficult to know who's behind the screen when it comes to online world.
- RISK OF ADDICTION**: Many games can feature addictive gameplay mechanics that keep players engaged for much longer. Like most games, they have the potential to be addictive, with constant rewards via in-game unlocks and currencies, which can encourage players to remain online for long periods of time.
- SCAMS**: Many of the games on Roblox feature collectible items, such as characters, items, and digital art, which are worth a lot of real money. In certain cases, these items can be sold for real money. However, if you're not careful, you could be scammed by younger users in the hopes of getting more Roblox money. Scammers will often use social engineering to trick you into handing them over via in-game chat.

Advice for Parents & Educators

- MONITOR THE CONTENT**: While Roblox does implement plenty of moderation tools and parental controls, it's up to parents and educators to monitor the types of games a child is engaging with. If a youngster wants to play Roblox, be sure to check out which specific games they want to play within it, and get a good idea of their content.
- TAKE ADVANTAGE OF TOOLS**: Use the parental controls within the game itself and teach youngsters how to report and block other players. Knowing the parents within their friends list will make it easier to report and block other players. You can also set age ratings for who is allowed to contact you, disable chat boxes, block advertising, and even filter out Roblox profile cards.
- PLAY TOGETHER**: Consider playing Roblox with the children in your care. There are a few more effective ways to see how moderation works, since whether the game could lead to addictive gameplay, or even appears how harassment, is often easier to see when you're playing together. This should help you figure out whether it's suitable for particular children.
- TEACH ONLINE BEHAVIOURS**: Have an open conversation about the risks of online play and how to spend money wisely. By using in-game money, you can have a more controlled and safe experience. Any user can be reported to Roblox moderators by other players for behaviour inappropriately. With this knowledge, younger players can be aware of what to look for and help prevent it.




Our children and staff enjoyed a wonderful time celebrating stories, characters, and the joy of reading.



