Dear Families,

Firstly a huge thank you to all the families and staff who turned up last Saturday for our **DIY Day**. They came with energy, skills, tools and so much wood! Everyone worked so hard and we managed to: fill the sandpit for use at lunchtime, make a hedge to block Barnhill's fence at the bottom of the field, made a new digging area, a balance beam course and a stage for use at lunchtime, made a forest school area so our Forest School sessions can start after Easter, clear the poly tunnel so we now have 6 beds ready for planting, make 3 beautiful raised flower beds, put up fencing, swept leaves, picked up litter. 



Do you want to enhance your skills and become part of a team that support our children's future's and play a pivotal role in education?

Here at Learn Hillingdon we deliver training to get you started in just that. We have a variety of courses for all abilities and learning styles.

Take a look at the courses we have on offer that can springboard your childcare career!

Pathways course - The course includes the roles and responsibilities of the key workers, through to health and safety, working with others and exploring how volunteering for community organisations can further progress their careers.

Childcare courses - We can support you towards a career as an early years practitioner in nurseries or pre-schools, or a support role in primary and secondary schools, including learning support assistants, teaching assistants or learning mentors.

Become a childminder - The purpose of this course is to prepare you to set up a home-based childcare setting or be employed in home-based roles such as childminding assistants.

Wraparound childcare - The role of a wraparound care assistance includes the delivery of breakfast clubs and after school clubs. This role is to support the delivery of high-quality wraparound provisions within a school or private setting. This is a term time only role on part-time hours.

You're probably well aware of WhatsApp and its huge user-base. The app has become a go-to for a convenient and easy way to keep in touch on an individual basis as well as in groups.

But are there any possible risks, and how safe is it for children? Here's everything you need to know.

5 tips to keep kids safe on WhatsApp

- 1 Review privacy settings** WhatsApp has a range of privacy and security settings to keep users safe. Customise groups, app access, live location and more.
- 2 Customise contacts** Show your child how to report and block unwanted contacts. Then, work with them to add their friends and family. Review and talk about their contacts regularly.
- 3 Talk about personal information** Make sure your child understands what personal information is. Talk about the importance of keeping that information private on WhatsApp.
- 4 Show them where to get support** If something goes wrong or they see something worrying on WhatsApp, make sure they know to come to you, and talk about other sources of support.
- 5 Check in regularly** Once you've done all of the above, check in with them regularly to review settings and how they use WhatsApp.
