Re. Something special

Our topic in reception this term is based around friendships, how to make friends, what is it that makes a good friend. We are encouraging the children to ask each other questions, what they like, what is special to them.

So we are asking if each child is able to bring in something that is special to them, some ideas are below;

- A photograph-of a special day/time/event/celebration.
- A small toy-with meaning. They will be asked why it is special to them, where they got it, who gave it to them etc.
- A story book-could be a favourite bedtime story.

Whatever they bring in to school for this activity will need to be small enough to fit in their tray.

It may be that whatever they bring into school will need to be in school for a few days. We won't be able to look and talk about all 30 children's special items in one day.

We only need one thing, just on this one occasion for this activity to happen.
