

## PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

We will be learning what weaving is and how to weave. This will develop our fine motor skills further. We will be watching clips of Africa drumming and dancing, learning some African dance moves ourselves.



## UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

This project teaches children about the global community to which they belong and explores how living things, communities and climates differ around the world. We will be inviting parents, grandad parents and local community members into school to talk about their heritage. This supports children's understanding that the United Kingdom is a multi-ethnic society, and the people who live in the UK have many different cultural backgrounds.

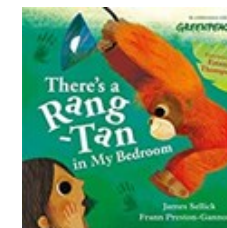

## COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

We will be having many discussions around this wonderful project. Discussions such as, recycling, why we need to recycle and how. Animals around the world and why live in the countries that they do. Different habits, both for animals and people around the world. Looking closely at a globe and maps, working out where we are, other countries are and how we may get to other countries.

## EXPRESSIVE ART AND DESIGN

We will be looking at traditional art from around the world. Children will learn about the Aboriginal people who live in Australia, pointing Australia out on the globe. Looking at patterns in their paintings, children will be invited to create their own Aboriginal style paintings and patterns.



## PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

We will be reading the book 'Under the same sky' This book looks at different countries, addressing that although we may live somewhere that could be very different to where we do, we all feel the same. We will be looking at ourselves, similarities and differences and promoting that even though we may be all different, we are all wonderful, unique and amazing.

## MATHS

We will be learning how to automatically recall number bonds to 5 and some numbers bonds to 10, including double facts. We will be continuing to copy, create and repeat patterns. Exploring and representing patterns within numbers within number up to 10. Including odds, evens, doubles, facts and how quantities can be distribute equally.

## LITERACY

In this project children will be using many different forms of writing, letters, postcards, notes, facts, lists and making passports. Children will be writing where they would like to live in the world and why, making lists of ingredients from a recipe from around the world.
