- Creative writing and letter formation.


## Books we are sharing in school:


This term we will be looking at a range of books relating to dinosaurs:


# Books to read/listen to and at home:

#### Maths:

- Explore subitising in increasingly complex arrangements.
- Explore the composition of numbers (for example, know that 5 and 5 make 10).
- Order and compare numbers using manipulatives.
- Explore sharing and grouping.
- Explore 2D and 3D shapes.

## Things to create for Dojo points:

- Practice using the correct letter formation and writing simple sentences.
- Create something for your garden (bug hotel, bird feeder, fairy garden).
- Learn a new nursery rhyme and perform it in class using actions.
- Make a collage out of natural objects.
- Create a chalk mural on a path or patio.
- Take a photo of you gardening or planting your own seeds.
- Take a photo of you exercising (eg completing an obstacle course, playing ball games).

#### Places to visit:

- Go on a wild flower hunt, remember to take a picnic for when you need a break.
- Feed the ducks at your local park and see what other wildlife you can spot.
- Go fruit-picking and then help make a fruit smoothie.
- Practice ball games in your garden or at your local park.
- Visit your local pool to build water confidence and practice those swimming skills.
- Visit the postbox to send a postcard you have made.
- Visit the Natural History Museum, Science Museum or Young V&A.
