Topics we will be learning about:


- 'Creepy Crawlies and Curious Critters' a unit that explores the lives of bugs.
- 'Little Green Fingers' a unit that looks at what plants need to grow and thrive.




This term we will be looking at a range of books relating to various insects and growing plants:

Books to read/listen to and at home:



























Maths:

- Practice counting from 0-30, noting the repeated pattern of counting.
- Compare numbers 1-10 using the terms 'more than', 'less than' and 'equal to'.
- Partition numbers up to 10 (for example, know that 2 and 6 make 8).
- To explore measure (capacity, length and height) and look into the concept of time.

Things to create for Dojo points:

- Make your own creation using playdough.
- Read a story at home and retell your favourite part in class.
- Create a bug or flower mask, model or painting.
- Learn a new nursery rhyme and perform it in class using actions.
- Writing, colouring or painting your name or short words (sheep, duck, letter)
- Take a photo of you gardening or planting your own seeds.
- Take a photo of you exercising (eg completing an obstacle course, playing ball games).

Places to visit:

- Go on a nature walk to try and spot the first signs of spring.
- Go on a bug hunt in your garden or local park.
- Visit the postbox to send a celebration card you have made.
- Visit the supermarket to buy groceries for a meal you can cook with your family.
- Visit a farm or zoo to learn about different animals and see them up close.
- Visit your local library and borrow a book to read.
