This term in Nursery, your child will be participating in some exciting new learning. To get your child ready for their learning and to support their learning at home, we have collated some ideas for you and your child to enjoy together when at home and when out and about.

Topics we will be learning about:

Adventure into Friendship and Feelings

This topic helps children learn about friendship, kindness, and what makes them and their families special. Through the story *The Colour Monster*, they will explore different feelings, learn to talk about their emotions, and think about how others might feel.

Everyday Superheroes

This topic explores the people in our community who help us, such as paramedics and firefighters, with exciting opportunities to meet them. Children will learn to appreciate those who care for them, while also recognising the importance of their own families and the special people in their lives.

Nursery Rhymes Children will have fun singing rhymes while building early language skills.

In maths this term we will be exploring numbers up to 5 by counting in order, clapping or copying fingers to represent the numbers.

Places to visit:

- A local park—to allow children to explore, work together, talk about family outings, friendship, feelings connected with nature (peace, excitement, calm, wonder).
- Visit the countryside, woodlands to look at the changes in nature.
- Visit a library to look for the topic books.
