So that you can start getting your children ready for their residential, please see what they should pack in the Kit List below:

Clothing	Toiletries	Other
Several pairs of comfortable trousers (preferably not jeans as they are uncomfortable if they become wet)	Washbag	Warm hat, gloves and scarf
Warm clothing such as a tracksuit, long and short-sleeved t-shirts and a couple of fleeces / jumpers	soap	1 small backpack for the day
Waterproof jacket	Shampoo/conditioner	 named refillable water bottle
Underwear and socks	toothbrush	Named bin bag for wet and dirty clothing
Pyjamas	toothpaste	Watch or alarm clock
Suitable sleepwear	Roll on deodorant (no spray on deodorants)	Day rucksack (to take on bus and large enough to contain a packed lunch, drinks bottle, and wet weather gear). Please note that if arriving in the morning, groups will not have access to their main bags until being shown to their rooms around 5pm, so pack what you need for the first day into your smaller day bag.
2 x towels (please note that they do not provide towels and do not have washing or drying facilities for drying towels	Hair ties (for long hair)	A book to read, or small travel games
Underwear	Sanitary products (if required)	Medicines/inhalers as required in a labelled bag (to be given to school beforehand)

Indoor shoes (e.g., clean trainers or slippers) Outdoor shoes or boots - wellies or walking boots are recommended Trainers with non-marking soles, suitable for the sports hall		Packed lunch: if you are arriving on site before lunch on the first day, make sure that you have a packed lunch in your bag.
