### Dear Families

We have high expectations for behaviour at Belmore. We want children to be happy, try their best and learn well. We have noticed some play fighting this week and also some swearing and bad language. Although this often starts with children playing and trying to be funny or silly it often turns into children feeling upset and getting hurt. Please talk to your children, fighting and swearing is not acceptable behaviour at school.

Lots of children tell us about seeing fighting or hearing swear words online. Make sure you check the content your child is watching at home using age restricted sites such as You Tube Kids. This is a helpful guide to You Tube— You can find the whole poster on our Instagram and Facebook pages. If you are at all worried about behaviour please talk to your Year Group Leader or myself or any member of the Senior Leadership Team.
