Message from Miss Taunt

Dear Families

Some staffing news for you this week. We are very pleased that we have filled all vacancies now with permanent staff! This makes a massive difference to how the school runs and we're really pleased how all the new staff have settled in.

We have had 3 members of support staff join us in the last 2 weeks. Mr Woods and Ms Fahim have joined our HLTA team, both with lots of experience working in schools and covering lessons. Mrs Marquis has joined Ms Pitcher as a Pastoral HLTA supporting behaviour and SEND across the school. Mrs Marquis has extensive experience of working in schools particularly with children with SEND.

Mr Gohil is sadly leaving us at Christmas to take up post as Inclusion Assistant Head Teacher at a new school. We wish him all the best in his new role. We will have Mr Cotter join us in January to cover the role of SENDCo while we recruit someone permanent for September 2025. Mr Cotter is currently a deputy head and SENDCo and we are grateful that he can join our team with plenty of knowledge and experience to continue the work Mr Gohil has started with children across the school. We will be holding a Coffee Morning on Wednesday 11th December after drop off where you can meet Mr Cotter ahead of him starting in January.

We are very lucky to have a staff team who are so dedicated to teaching and nurturing the children at Belmore. They work extremely hard in giving the very best learning experiences to every single one of our children.

Please can I remind you that abuse of any kind will not be tolerated towards our staff. I am concerned about the amount of verbal and written abuse our staff experience from families. Staff are happy to help but please speak respectfully and if you are angry, choose a time when you can speak appropriately to staff. Repeated incidents of abuse of staff will lead to a ban from the school site.

We want to continue working closely and positively with families and parents to support our children. We will be launching Class Dojo for all families next week so you can log in and see how many points your child has been awarded and you're able to message the teachers directly. Look out for the letters with the link to connect to your class next week


