#### Welcome back!

It has been so lovely to see you all this week.

The children have had a brilliant start to the term, and we're very pleased to welcome our new children to Nursery, Reception, and other year groups across the school.

In KS1 week, 3 children with 100% attendace from the week before aree chosen to receive prizes of attendance stickers, pencils and wristbands.


In KS2, all children who have 95% that term are entered into a raffle with 2 children being picked to win toy shop prizes.


#### **Out of School Achievements**

Please send the award in with your child on a Friday, and we will share their achievement during our assembly.










We have seen the traffic and parking getting worse in Owen Road.


