### Dear Families

It was brilliant to see so many children wearing yellow for Mental Health Day yesterday. We had special assemblies talking about mental health and for Years 3-6 we talk about who can talk to when we are feeling sad, stressed, worried or angry. We used our hand to remember: 2 people from family or friends, 2 adults in school and the thumb was Childline. We shared the phone number for children to call and we have this displayed around school. We talked about the importance of being able to talk about how we are feeling.

We use the rewards and are looking forward to celebrating the Dojo achievements at the end of this half term.
