I like/dislike, telling time (hour)

Comparing the differences in city and countryside life during during WWII

## LE WEEK-END (The weekend)

Telling time accurately, what I do at the week-end

Francophone countries, different festivals, protecting my planet

# MANGER ET BOUGER (Healthy lifestyles)

Recognising foods and drinks that are considered good/bad for health, activities to keep a healthy lifestyle

#### LES ANIMAUX (Animals)

Animals, je suis - (I am)

## LES FRUITS (Fruits)

Fruits, giving opinion

# LES GLACES (The ice creams)

Different flavours of ice creams, asking for an ice cream and saying which flavour they like

# JE PEUX (I am able to...)

Common French verbs, making simple sentences



# LA FAMILLE (The family)

Family members, numbers to 100, possessive adjectives

# AS-TU UN ANIMAL? (Do you have a pet?)

Pets, to say which pet I have/don't have, to say what my pet is called

## CHEZ MOI (My home)

Nouns for place I live which rooms I have/don't have in my home

## LES VÊTEMENTS (The clothes)

Clothes, to use verb porter (to wear), different clothing for different weather, describing colour of clothes

## AU SALON DE THÉ (At the tea room)

Order a selection of food and drinks (breakfast/lunch), to ask for the bill, café role play
