<p>Topic 1</p>	<p>Adventure into Friendship and Feelings</p> <p>This topic teaches children about how they are unique and special, and the importance of friendship and kindness. Children will first be introduced to the book <i>All Are Welcome</i>, which celebrates diversity and shows how everyone is welcome in our school, no matter how different we are. This topic helps children settle into new school rules and routines while building confidence in their class. It encourages them to form friendships and develop social skills by promoting kindness, helpfulness, and thoughtfulness at home and in school. Using <i>The Colour Monster</i> book as a key resource, children explore different emotions, learn to express their feelings, and understand how others might feel. This topic supports personal, social, and emotional development by fostering a sense of belonging, improving communication, and encouraging positive interactions with others.</p>	<p>Autumn Adventures</p> <p>This topic helps children explore the changes that happen in autumn. They will learn about colder weather, falling leaves, and how animals get ready for winter. Through play and outdoor activities, they will use their senses to discover the season. With the stories <i>Squirrel's Busy Day</i> and <i>Owl Babies</i>, children will learn about working together, feeling safe, and how animals prepare for the colder months.</p>	<p>Fantastic Fairy Tales</p> <p>This topic helps children develop a love of stories and reading. They will listen to, retell, and act out well-known traditional tales such as <i>Cinderella</i>, <i>Goldilocks and the Three Bears</i>, <i>Little Red Riding Hood</i>, <i>The Three Little Pigs</i>, and <i>The Three Billy Goats Gruff</i>. Through role-play and storytelling, children will build their language skills, imagination, and confidence while having fun bringing their favourite stories to life.</p>	<p>Creepy Crawlies and Curious Critters</p> <p>This topic helps young children explore the tiny creatures living in their gardens and nearby areas. They will look at insects and creepy crawlies, learning how they move and what makes them special. Through this, children will practice observing, ask questions, and develop a curiosity about nature.</p>	<p>Revolutionary Robot and Mighty Machines</p> <p>This topic sparks children's curiosity about the technology around them, with a special focus on how robots and machines help us in everyday life. Children will explore how different machines work, discover how robots are built, and have fun creating their own robotic designs. Through hands-on activities, they'll gain a deeper understanding of technology and how it shapes our world.</p>	<p>Wild Wonders of the World</p> <p>This topic helps children explore animals and people from different places around the world, both on land and in the sea. They will learn about animals that live in hot and cold places and how they survive there. Through the story <i>Meerkat Mail</i>, children will follow a meerkat as he travels to different places and experiences new environments. This will help children talk about where animals live, what they do, and how life is different in different parts of the world. It encourages children to use new words and ask questions about what they discover.</p>
<p>Topic 2</p>	<p>Everyday Superheroes</p> <p>The topic will explore the people in our local community who help us, such as paramedics and firefighters, and children will have the exciting opportunity to meet these everyday superheroes through visits. This topic encourages children to appreciate the people who support and care for them, while fostering a sense of belonging and understanding of their own importance in the world. It also focuses on the importance of family and the people who care for them.</p>	<p>Birthday Bashes and Festive Fun</p> <p>This topic helps children explore the special celebrations that happen during the autumn and winter seasons, with a focus on birthdays and the unique ways people celebrate them. Children will learn about the importance of different celebrations and what makes them meaningful. They will also enjoy a magical Elf School experience at Christmas, discovering fun traditions and the joy of giving. Through these activities, children will understand the significance of these festive times and what makes them special to them.</p>		<p>Little Green Fingers</p> <p>This topic helps children learn what plants and animals need to grow and thrive, with a special focus on planting and caring for their own plants. Children will explore the life cycle of plants, from seeds to full-grown plants, and experience the magic of growth firsthand. They'll enjoy the stories of <i>Jack and the Beanstalk</i> and <i>The Very Hungry Caterpillar</i>, and have the chance to watch real-life butterflies grow and change. Through these hands-on activities, children will develop an understanding of how life changes and how to nurture the world around them.</p>		<p>Amazing Animals</p> <p>This topic helps children discover the wonderful animals that live all around the world, teaching them how to care for animals and the importance of looking after our environment. They'll explore animals that live on land, in the sea, and in both hot and cold climates, learning about their unique differences. Through fun activities like enjoying the book <i>Doing the Animal Bop</i>, reading <i>Dear Zoo</i>, and joining in the adventure of <i>We're Going on a Bear Hunt</i>, children will expand their understanding of animals and nature while developing their vocabulary and having lots of fun along the way!</p>
