Message from Miss Taunt

Dear Families,

The children are currently having a wonderful time at the PTA Summer Party, and we have raised over £1,000 for the school. We are sorry that some children were disappointed after missing the deadline to buy tickets. We always send multiple reminders and communications to avoid this; however, we must ensure we have enough staff and refreshments for the event to run safely.

Thank you to all families who have made an effort with attendance this week. We had 50 more children achieving 100% attendance compared to last week - keep it up!

The children were informed of their classes for next year today. We hope that both you and your child find the extended transition period useful. We are very fortunate to have such highly skilled and experienced teachers, who are also kind, caring, and genuinely supportive. As always, we will support your child through this period of change. Please do let us know if you have any additional concerns or queries.

We are currently gathering feedback about the school through our annual Ofsted survey. Last year, we received 139 responses; this year, we have received 36 so far. Lastly, we have extended our nursery provision for September meaning that parents can choose their sessions for nursery as well as topping up their funded hours with extra sessions at the cost of £4.50 an hour.
