Dear Families

Due to the current weather warnings issued for this week, we are writing to inform you of changes to the school day in order to ensure the safety of our pupils and staff.

We would firstly like to apologise to parents who experienced extended waiting times at early pick-up today. We underestimated the number of parents who would arrive at that time and will take this into account moving forward.

We have reviewed current classroom temperatures, guidance from the Department for Education and Hillingdon Council, as well as the plans being put in place by other local schools.

On **Tuesday**, an **Amber Weather Warning** is in place. In line with guidance followed by nearby schools, including Barnhill School, our school will **close early at 12:45pm**. Children will have lunch at school as normal before home time. We kindly ask that arrangements are made to collect your child promptly at this time in the normal way from classrooms. There will be no after-school clubs.

For **Wednesday and Thursday**, a **Red Weather Warning** has been issued. Due to the significant risk posed by these conditions and to prioritise the health and safety of our school community, the school will be **closed on both days**.

Work for pupils will be set on **ClassDojo for Wednesday and Thursday** to support continuity of learning during the school closure.

School will **reopen on Friday**. To allow for a safe and flexible return, there will be a **soft start**, with pupils able to arrive any time up until **9:30am**.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation during this time. Further updates will be shared if there are any changes.
