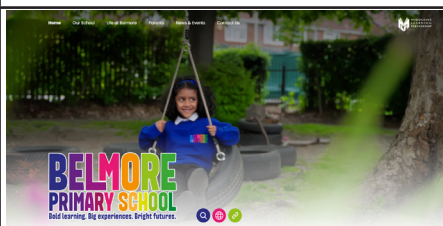
I love working at Belmore and will never stop wanting it to be even better for our children and families.
